





Creating masks is, indeed, an art in Venice, a tradition dating back hundreds of years, making the carnival of Venice truly unique.

Eagle's Filght (St Mark's Square)

The Eagle's Flight is one of the most interesting events of Venice Carnival. The celebration, recalls the ancient art of Renaissance Theatre Machineries in which Venice was an expert. Watch a flying man dressed up as the Eagle fly from the top of **Saint Mark's bell tower** to the center of the Square.





Venice Guided Visit

During the tour, we will delve into the history of this beautiful city popularly known as the **Queen of the Adriatic**. We will walk through its streets, admire its canals and look at the facades of its most emblematic buildings, starting with the **La Fenice theater**.

Next, we will approach **St. Mark's Square**. Here, we will look at the architectural details of the **Basilica of San Marcos**, whose origins date back to the 12th century. We will see the bell tower, which is almost 100 meters high, and we will tell you about the different uses that the **Doge's Palace** has had.

We will continue the guided tour of Venice walking around the exteriors of the **Contarini del Bovolo Palace**, a unique example of Venetian Gothic architecture and one of the most curious buildings in this beautiful Italian city. Of course, we will walk along the **Grand Canal in Venice** to admire the panorama of the palaces and churches that are on its banks, highlighting the majestic Baroque temple of the **Basilica of Santa María della Salute**.



Gondola Ride


Is there anything more typically Venetian than a Gondola? On this ride, you will discover the canals of the city from the most romantic and traditional point of view.

Carnival Costume Contest.

The most awesome costumes are displayed during a "**costume contest**" in St Mark's Square and Venice is the perfect back-drop for the best amazing photographs.









Fly of the Lion

The so-called "**Svolo del Leon**" puts symbolically the word end to the Carnival events.

It is a huge canvas of San Marco that represents the famous winged lion that will be raised with a system of pulleys, from the square where the coronation of the "Maria" winner of the Carnival formerly took place, up to St Mark's bell tower.

In the background, the musicians of the **Fenice BrassOpera** will play the anthem of San Marco. The event is a ritual of great beauty, a tribute to the city's landmark, the winged lion-so dear to Venetians-which close the Carnival.










- Free evening


